

## təməsewtx<sup>w</sup> Aquatic and Community Centre

The təməsewx Aquatic and Community Centre in New Westminster, BC, aims to be the heart and soul of the community and a place for all to connect. Woven into the landscape with a dramatic unifying roof, the building makes a strong, civic statement while being sensitive to the natural environment and human-scale experience.

The centre has been designed for all ages and abilities, and for how communities engage in recreation today and into the future. It includes a four-pool aquatic centre with sauna and steam rooms, universal washrooms and change rooms, a fitness centre, gymnasia, community rooms, licensed childcare, administrative offices, as well as significant new plazas and greenspaces.

təməsewtx<sup>w</sup> Aquatic and Community Centre is Canada's first Zero Carboncertified aquatic centre, aiming for a 90% reduction in GHG emissions and eliminating fossil fuels emissions completely. The name təməsewtx<sup>w</sup> means "Sea Otter House" in hənqəminəm, and was gifted by an advisory panel of urban Indigenous people and local First Nations.
